

BRADLEY SCHOOL RULES

The School Rules have been developed to ensure fair play, safety, acceptable behavior and standards for student control.

1. Students are to show proper respect for all students and adults at school.
2. Students are not to arrive on campus before 8:25 a.m. if eating breakfast or 8:40 a.m. if not eating breakfast.
3. No loitering is allowed on the grounds before or after school.
4. Students are not allowed in the office unless a pass has been issued by an adult on staff.
5. Students may only leave campus with parent/guardian consent and school office approval.
6. No candy, gum, snacks or sodas are to be brought to school unless authorized for approved school functions/parties.
7. Students are not to bring balls, bats, toys, or other play equipment from home. This includes electronic games, radios, tape players, or any other personal items, such as purses, body glitter, fake fingernails, etc.
8. Shoes are to be closed toes for the safety of students.
9. Students may not bring felt tip makers, knives or sharp items, or toys resembling weapons, such as knives or guns.
10. No campus loiter is allowed between or around the buildings throughout the day.
11. Students are to remain on their designated playground during all recess times.
12. Students should use the bathroom facilities and the drinking fountains during recess and return directly to the playground area.
13. Fighting, threatening, cursing, teasing, or throwing of objects will NOT be tolerated.
14. Students are to seek help from adults on duty when disputes or rule violation occur. Problems are not to be solved by physical means.
15. Playground problems not resolved by yard duty supervisors will be referred to the students' teachers.
16. Students are to stop playing immediately when the bell rings, freeze and wait for directions to line up from the adults on duty.
17. During mealtime, all food and drink items are to be finished at the eating table. Students are to raise their hands to be dismissed, by school personnel, from the tables.
18. Activities deemed unsafe will be discontinued by staff members.
19. Bicycles may be ridden by students in grades 4-6. The school will provide space for parking, however, will not assume responsibility for them. State law requires students to wear helmets while riding their bicycles.
20. Roller skates, roller blades, and or skateboards are not allowed on campus at any time... by order of the Board of Education.
21. Siblings are to meet at their designated agate at dismissal and are not to go to each other's classrooms. Parents are to pick up their children at the gates.
